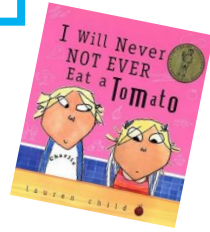
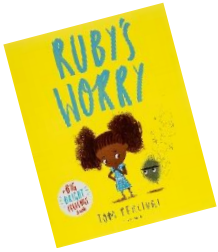
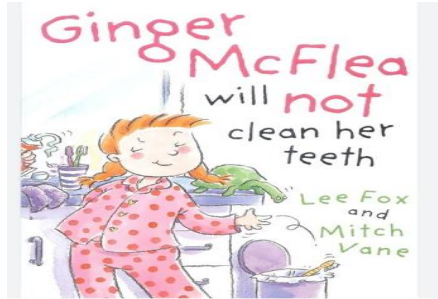


What's happening in Year 1?

During this half term we will be exploring the theme 'How can we stay healthy?' We will be exploring different fruits and talking about how a balanced diet is important. We will also look into how exercise and our mental health is important too.



During Phonics we will continue teaching the phase 5 sounds and learning alternative pronunciations. There will be many opportunities for the children to practice and apply their new knowledge using a variety of resources. The children are becoming really confident at writing sentences independently using their sounds and knowledge of tricky words.



How can we stay healthy?

During English lessons, we will continue to focus on our writing toolkits and practicing applying key skills and techniques when writing. As part of our learning, we will be writing a letter to Ruby from 'Ruby's worry', creating shape poetry all about fruit and writing instructions to help Ginger Mcflea brush her teeth!

In Maths, we will be continuing our focus of numbers to 10 using part whole models and numberlines. The children will also have the opportunity to recognise, compose, decompose and manipulate 2D and 3D shapes.

Remember, talk is a great tool for learning so please encourage your child to talk about their learning and to explain their thinking.



As part of our theme we will be exploring how we keep our bodies healthy, tasting new food and creating our own fruit salad in DT. We will also continue to talk about the weather and discuss the continents and hot and cold areas of the world.
